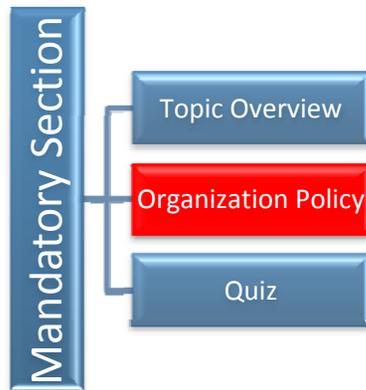
Topic Overview:

password policy



1. Users shall use at least 8 characters or more to create a password.
2. User password shall have various combinations of characters. This shall include a combination of lowercase, uppercase, numbers and special characters etc.
3. Users shall avoid using the words from dictionary for creating passwords.
4. Users shall not write down passwords.
5. Users should change system and application passwords every 60 days.
6. Users shall not repeat the last 5 previously used passwords.
